Gordon Hastie Bursary

This is a local club initiative which commenced in 2021 In honour of a local legend among our Rotary club and wider community Gordon Hastie.

The bursary recognises students who are willing to share their ideas about youth, environment and all things community displaying potential leadership traits.

Students are invited to apply with the successful applicant receiving a bursary amount to be applied against cost to enhance their education.



Rotary Youth Program of Enrichment (RYPEN)

Is a weekend residential program for young people (Years 9 & 10).

Its principal aim, to communicate to participants a series of ideas, problems and social experiences which will assist them in forming their own values and moral standards and allow them to broaden their horizons culturally, socially and academically.

Activities focus on increasing self-esteem and leadership skills as well as allowing opportunities for them to think about understanding themselves and how they relate to others.



Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA)

An intensive program that brings young adults together from ages 18-30 to further develop character and leadership skills and learn about Rotary.

District 9790 RYLA Conference is an experience-based conference consisting of 7 days and 6 nights organised by previous RYLArians, Rotaractors and Rotarians from across the District.

Participants are nominated by local Rotary clubs or self-nominate after hearing about the conference through friends.



National Youth Science Forum (NYSF)



Provides a unique experience for Australia's best Year 11 school students who are interested in science.

Each student is exposed to the widest possible range of study and career opportunities in science, technology and engineering so that they can make an informed choice for further studies.

Participants are chosen after a personal interview by the interview committee and attend a 10 day program designed around careers in STEM.

Rotary Youth Exchange - (RYE) in/out-bound

An opportunity for young people to experience a year of education overseas in a wide range of countries. It also provides many personal experiences and opportunities during and after the year of exchange.

Rotary's Youth Exchange Program is recognised by participants, parents and schools as the best student exchange program in the world. It is the largest of its type in Australia and it is backed up by caring and dedicated Rotarians who provide the infrastructure of the program.
