- An intensive program for young adults from ages 18-30
- develops character and leadership skills
- consists of 7 days and 6 nights
- organised by previous RYLArians, Rotaractors and Rotarians
- Participants are nominated by local Rotary clubs or selfnominate.

rotary youth exchange

- Rotary Youth Exchange is an incredible opportunity for young people to experience a new culture and gain invaluable life skills.
- Rotary International, a worldwide network of volunteer-based service clubs, organises these exchanges to build global understanding and peaceful resolution of conflicts.
- The program typically lasts one school year & involves both inbound and outbound students.



- A weekend residential program for young people (Years 9 & 10).
- Principal aim is to communicate to participants a series of ideas, problems & social experiences which will assist them in forming own values and moral standards allowing them to broaden their horizons culturally, socially and academically.
- Has a big focus on increasing self esteem and leadership skills
